The District is well known for its involvement in the avenue of Community Service. Projects include a crematorium, tree planting and a neonatal ward at a local hospital.

The GSE members were hosted by the Allentown and Emmaus Clubs. GSE chairperson is Cindy Hornaman from Emmaus. Many of the host families joined us this evening as did many District 7430 dignitaries including DG Mike McCarthy and several past and future DG's.

The team was led by Rotarian P. Balasubramanian, the head of the Department of Metallurgy in Sakthi Polytechnic College in Erode.
