ROTARY TONIGHT

EXCELLENT!! That's how I would describe the dinner of watermelon salad, BBQ chicken, and pineapple tart. 2 ½ tables of Rotarians dined on such and enjoyed.

The 50-50 of \$30 (a \$5 ticket night) was won by Duane Snyder.

This Saturday is the pool party at Tony's, 12:30 to whenever. Next week is changeover, out with Karl and in with Leon. There is a board of directors meeting immediately after.

Tonight, Angus Murray, a fellow Rotarian from the Norristown club, presented a program on his employer, the Variety Club. This is an international, non-profit group founded in 1927 in Pittsburgh. The seminal incident involved abandoned baby Catherine, left on the steps of a theater, with a note pinned to her asking for the theater people to care for her. Like Rotary, humble beginnings led to the development of an international organization, this one focusing on providing services and programs to special-needs children. Their clubs are called "tents," harking back to show-business roots.

Tent 13, the Philadelphia branch, founded in 1935, opened its first camp for children in 1949, originally for polio survivors, but now embracing multiple childhood handicaps, such as autism, Down syndrome, and many other mental and physical disabilities. The overnight camp hosts 600 campers per summer, while the day camp serves about 60 campers daily. They also offer an extended school-year program and vocational training for young people age 15-21.

Angus was quite frank reviewing the fiscal problems of the Philadelphia tent, having amassed \$1.5 million in debt, including owing 440K to the IRS. Ironically, on the home page of their web site is a seal of 2007 National Fiscal Excellence Award Winner, #1 chapter in the country. How things can change.
