TONIGHT'S PROGRAM

Montgomery County Controller, Diane Morgan, was our speaker this evening. Diane is a graduate of Temple University where she received both a B.A. and M.A. in speech pathology. She was a business owner, insurance agent and activist. She and her husband Dave have 2 daughters and 4 grandsons

Diane founded DM&A, a rehabilitation agency providing speech therapy and other services to long term care facilities, hospitals, home health agencies and private clients. She sold the company 18 years later and turned her career to the sale of LTC insurance policies. Diane has worked with Citizens for a Better Ambler since 2004 and is a founding member of the Citizens Advisory Group that works with the EPA to find viable solutions to the 38 acre Bo-Rit asbestos site in Ambler. The site was listed on the National Priority List on April 9, 2009 and is currently a superfund site.

In 2007, Diane was elected Controller of Montgomery County. She is the first woman to hold that office in 165 years. Montgomery County is the third largest in the state covering 476 square miles and has a population of 800,000 (more than that of 6 states). The county has 3100 employees and has an annual budget in excess of \$400 million.

The Controller's office consists of 26 employees servicing 5 departments: general accounting, accounts payable, auditing, payroll and retirement. Diane has faced many challenges in her quest to make sure our money is spent efficiently. Something about the "good old boys network". Can you believe it? She currently plans to run for reelection next year.
